#### What is the Summer Graduate Teaching Scholars Program?

The Summer Graduate Teaching Scholars (SGTS) program provides an excellent opportunity for our top graduate students to participate in a faculty-mentored, professional development teaching program.

- Prior to summer SGTS students take 2 courses at the Engaged Teaching Hub.
- During summer Students teach a 2023 Summer Session course, attend weekly meetings with their SGTS cohort, and meet with their faculty mentor.
- SGTS participants receive the standard Summer Session Associate-In course salary, plus a \$1,200 stipend for participation in the required training.
- Faculty mentors receive a \$500 payment to their research account.

Priority will be given to graduate students who will be teaching as Associates-In for the first time. Please <u>visit the SGTS website</u> for program information and nomination instructions.
