#### Summer Course Modality Reminders

Great News regarding REMOTE Instruction APPROVED for Summer Session 2023

Academic Senate has endorsed an exception to the Policy on Distance Education Courses to allow any undergraduate or graduate course to be offered remotely in Summer 2023 without formal approval of the R designation. This means that Summer Session 2023 courses will have varying modalities remote, in-person, and hybrid. The next scheduling submission window opens on Wednesday, March 15, 2023.
