New Funding Model - High Impact Course List is Now Available!

High Impact courses are in demand. Academic Departments are encouraged to help improve the selection of high-impact courses taught during summer. The new funding model allocates an additional \$500 per high impact course to academic departments. Questions & Answers:

Is every section (same course, several sections) of a course that is on the approved list paid \$500? **Yes**

How often is the list updated? ***Courses are selected from the previous academic year 2022-2023.***

Do courses on the approved high impact list (\$500 per course) also qualify for the departmental incentive program of course enrollment \$50 and \$1000 per course? ***Yes. Academic departments are allocated \$500 + \$1,000 per course and \$50 per enrollment.***

March 21: Schedule will be available live.

The ISA is still open! Departments can still submit new courses for Summer 2024. Remote courses can be added up until one week before the start of summer session.

If your department would like to add or cancel courses, you can still enter information in the ISA Summer Session Builder. Summer Session will continue to approve new courses and cancellations in the ISA.

Summer Session will use the ISA to send faculty appointment letters.

Summer 2024 Associate Instructor Campaign Info

The IA System is now open for Summer Session 2024 Associates-In applications! All Associate Instructor (teaching a course) requests must be submitted through the IA System. We are expecting a lot of applications for summer 2024, so please make sure to give GEPA plenty of time to review your applications. Also, remember to allow extra time in case edits are needed. Effective *Summer 2024*, instructor compensation for teaching a standard Summer Session course will increase from 8.5% annual salary to 11% annual salary (determined by the salary point selected for the student). The deadline to submit your Schedule Build to the Registrar was February 1, 2024. If the department has already submitted their Schedule Build to the Registrar, and the department would like to

change the modality of any courses to remote, the Registrar will process schedule changes when *The Look* is released on March 13, 2024. Modality changes should be emailed directly to registrar-scheduling@ucsd.edu.

**Asynchronous courses should not have a day or time submitted to the registrar's office for scheduling.*

***Synchronous courses must include a day and time when submitting a request to the registrar's office.*
