EASy Open for Preauthorizations

Students can now submit preauthorization requests for Summer Session classes in the Enrollment Authorization System (EASy) <u>http://easy.ucsd.edu/</u>.

Visiting Students cannot enter preauthorization requests until they have PIDs. The Summer Session application becomes available on April 22 and provides students with PIDs.

Thank you for your participation in Summer Session 2024. We know there will be changes to the schedule between now and the start of summer, so we updated the <u>Guide on Managing Course Changes</u> on the Summer Session website. This guide has useful information as you navigate changing modality, instructor names, session of a class, adding new classes, cancellations, etc. Students are anxious about the modality of instruction of Summer Session courses. 75% of students are requesting Remote Instruction.

Questions & Answers:

- <u>Is every section (same course, several sections) of a course that</u> is on the approved list paid \$500?
 - Yes
- How often is the list updated?
 - Courses are selected from the previous academic year 2022-2023.
- <u>Do courses on the approved high impact list (\$500 per course)</u> also qualify for the departmental incentive program of course enrollment \$50 and \$1000 per course?</u>
 - Yes, academic departments are allocated \$500 + \$1,000 per course and \$50 per enrollment.
