What is the Summer Graduate Teaching Scholars Program?

The Summer Graduate Teaching Scholars (SGTS) program provides an excellent opportunity for some of our top graduate students to participate in a faculty-mentored, professional development teaching program. Priority will be given to graduate students who will be teaching as Associates-In for the first time.

- SGTS participants will teach a Summer Session 2022 class.
- Prior to summer - SGTS students attend 2 courses led by the Engaged Teaching Hub.
- During summer - Students attend weekly meetings with their SGTS cohort, and meet with their faculty mentor.
- SGTS participants will receive the standard Summer Session Associates-In course salary, and a \$1,200 payment for participation in the Engaged Teaching Hub training.
- Faculty mentors will receive a \$500 payment to a research account.
