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## **Schedule Build for Summer**

The Registrar Scheduling Office is now accepting Summer Session 2025 Schedules. Please plan to submit your Summer Session 2025 schedules by January 24th, to allow Summer Session to review – and no later than January 30th - to the Scheduling Office via the Schedule Submission Wizard within the ISA.

Summer Session has approved instructors who are already eligible to teach. Graduate students who need approval to teach from the GEPA Dean or visiting instructors who need approval from the AVC-EI, will be left as STAFF until their appointments are approved.

This is a friendly reminder that remote course modality has been approved by Academic Senate without a preapproved R-course designation for Summer 2025. Students are requesting more

flexibility during the summer, and Summer Session is asking departments to consider offering more remote courses for Summer Session 2025. Another important consideration is for courses identified by Academic Affairs leadership as high impact. IMPORTANT! Late schedules will not be processed until after "The Look" is sent to departments on March 12th, which means that if you need campus rooms, availability will be very limited. Please submit all schedules ASAP, to avoid missing the deadline. Summer Session will continue to leave the ISA open, however, schedules submitted after January 30th will not be processed until The Look is released on March 12th.
