Summer Session 2025 timeline:

April- Students will begin registering for courses on April 14.

The Registrar's office will be sending out The Look this week, please review and make any changes for courses that were submitted by the January 30th schedule build deadline. Any new courses that were approved after Jan. 30 should be emailed to the registrar by Friday, March 14, 2025.

The ISA is still open! Departments can still submit new courses for Summer 2025. Remote courses can be added up until one week before the start of summer session.

Summer Session Deadlines:

Enrollment will begin April 14, 2025 for continuing students and April 21, 2025 for new incoming and visiting students.

Intentional Growth for Summer 2025

Here are some tips to help grow summer in order to meet student demands:

- Read the new <u>Summer 2025 Growth Guide</u> on our website for recommendations on how to grow your summer enrollment.

- Consider increasing the total number of courses offered in 2025 by 3-5% over summer 2024 to meet student demand.
