Intentional Growth for Summer 2025

Here are some tips to help grow summer in order to meet student demands:

- Review the <u>High Impact Course list</u> to identify courses that will help students repeat a course.
- Consider increasing the total number of courses offered in 2025 by 3-5% over summer 2024 to meet student demand.
- Think about setting goals to achieve capacity initiative for courses by adding prior enrollment + prior waitlist.
