Summer Session 2025 timeline:

October - Academic departments & programs begin discussion of summer 2025 course offerings.

November - Use the Instructional Scheduling Assistant (ISA) to propose summer course offerings.

December - Courses are approved and the preview of classes is posted to the website. Departments & programs will then be able to check the approved status in the ISA.

January - Academic departments & programs work with the Registrar-Scheduling team on the initial scheduling submission.

- Introduction of a new Capacity Minimum Initiative.

- Instructor course salaries of 11% annual salary will continue.
- Department Incentive Package will continue at \$1,000/course + \$50/student
