#### Summer 2025 Dates:

Special Session: June 16- September 19, 2025

**October** - academic departments & programs begin discussion of summer 2025 course offerings.

**November** - use the Instructional Scheduling Assistant (ISA) to propose summer course offerings.

**December** - Courses are approved and the preview of classes is posted to the website

Departments & programs will then be able to check the approved status in the ISA

**January** - academic departments & programs work with the Registrar-Scheduling team on the initial scheduling submission.
