| Tuition + Fees       | Full Time or Part Time<br>Non-resident supplemental | Per Unit Fees<br>UC vs. Non-UC Rates<br>Non-resident fee is not charged |
| Housing              | Matriculating UCSD students                         | Open to ALL summer session students                                     |
| Financial Aid        | Pre-packaged for the year                           | Auto package for UCSD students<br>Minimum 6 units enrollment            |
| New Students         | Standard enrollment                                 | All students welcome  |
| Visiting Students    | Extension Concurrent Enrollment                     | Open Enrollment via WebReg  |

## Capacity Initiative

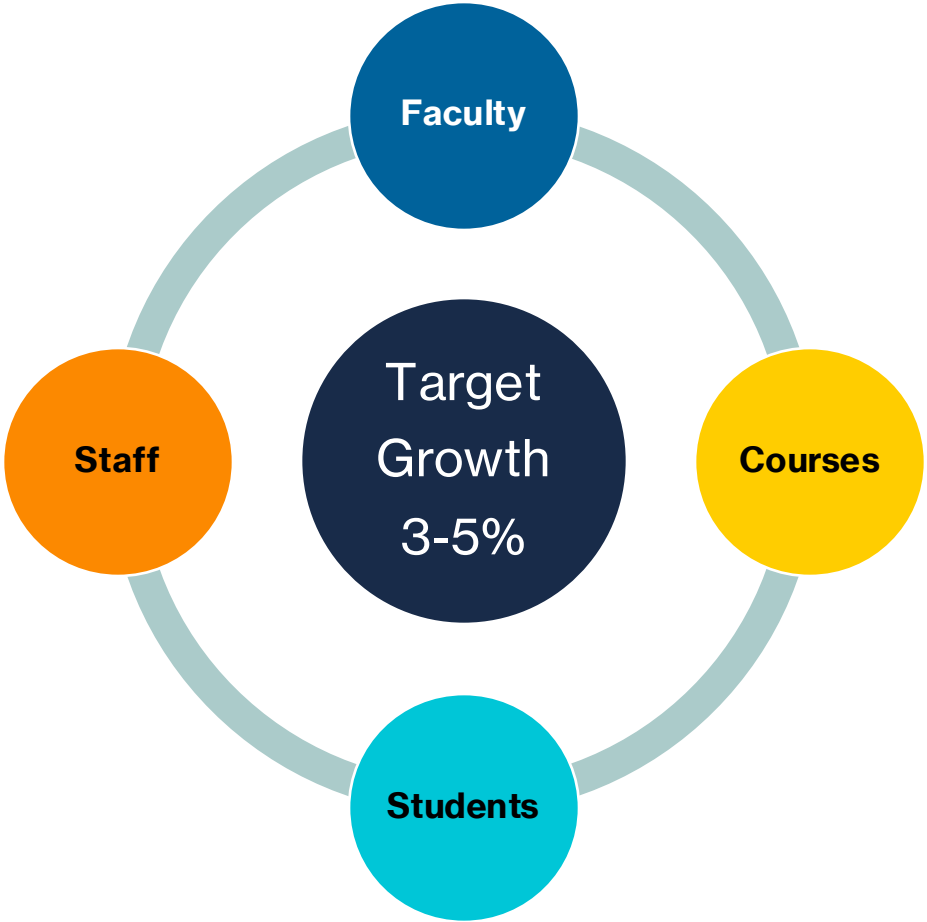
2024 Enrollment + Waitlisted Students

- Accommodate students on waitlists earlier (April)

- Increase TA support
- Teach full load

- More courses
- Increase remote modality

## Staff

- Reduce waitlists
- Increase communication to faculty and students

- Increase Advising tools
- Increase Financial Aid

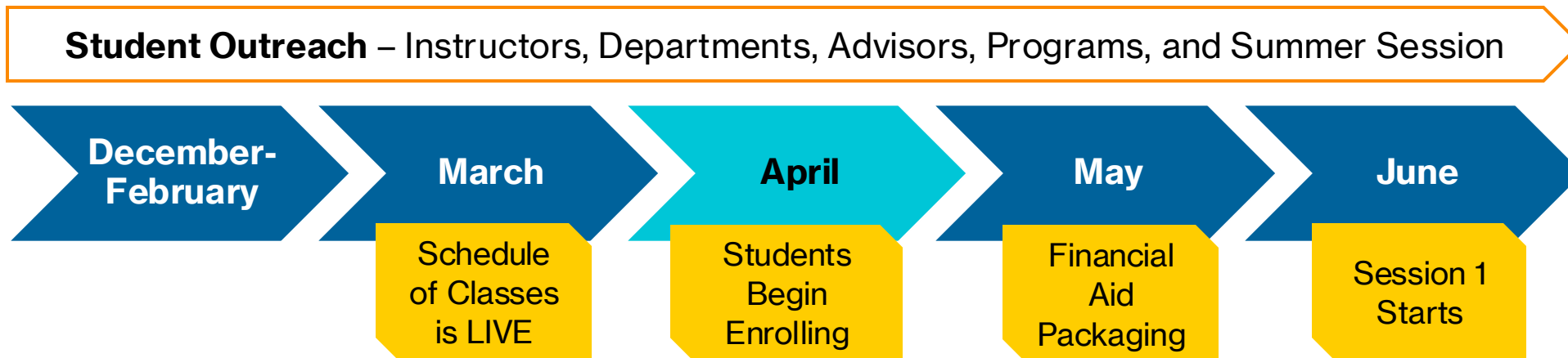

# Ideas for growing summer...

Summer planning should be a year-round effort.

Start promoting summer courses in Winter Quarter, while students are making their summer plans.

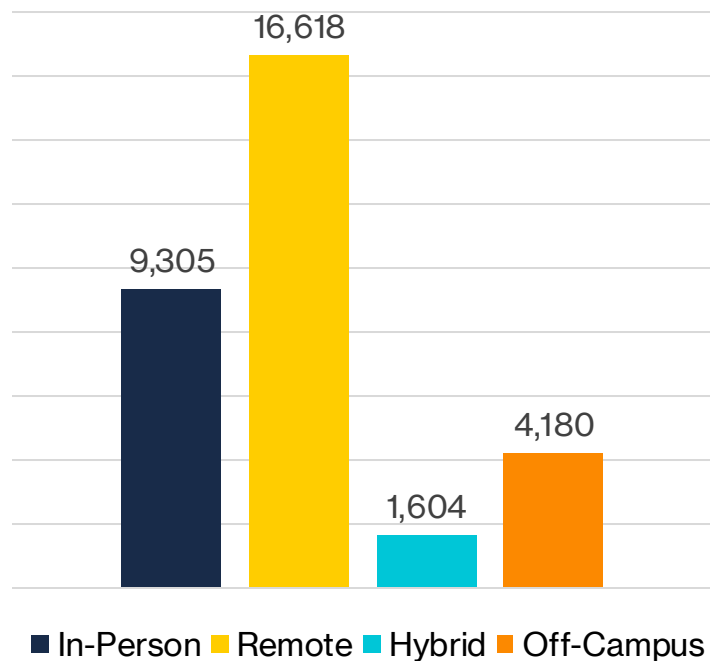


- Drip approach – Send periodic, intentional emails to students about summer classes.
- Add a link to the Summer Session website from your department website.
- Highlight and promote your summer courses on social media
- Post flyers promoting summer courses in department space.
- After enrollment begins – Manage waitlists
  - Help students understand if courses/sections will be increased

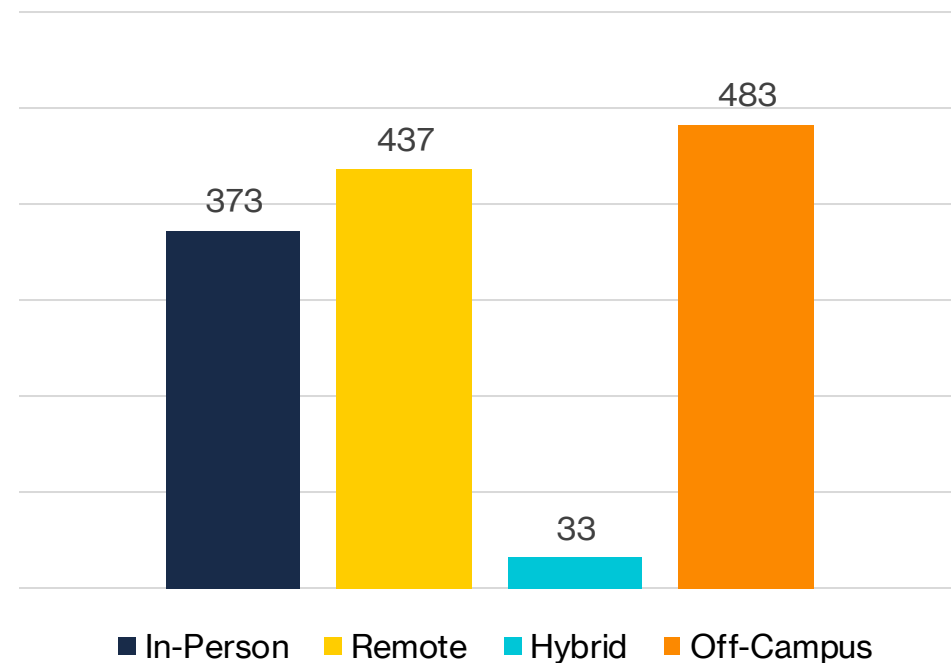
# What's New – Remote Modality Approved

Remote modality without R designation is approved for Summer 2025. Summer 2024 end-of-term data shows high student interest in remote courses.

**Enrollment: 31,707**



**Courses: 1,326**



# Summer 2025 - Funding Model

**Instructors - Payroll Expenses Funded** (course salaries + benefits + GL)

11% annual salary per 4-unit course

**Instructional Support - Payroll Expenses Funded** (course salaries + benefits + GL)

TAs, Tutors, and Readers

[TA pay rates](#) and [Tutor/Reader pay rates](#) on Summer Session website

**Department Incentive Package**

\$1,000/course + \$50/student

\$500/course for all courses on the [High Impact Course List](#)
